



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PROPOSED FARE INCREASE

GET ABOUT EXTENDED SERVICE AREA FARES

The Pomona Valley Transportation Authority will be holding a public hearing to consider a proposal to increase the Get About one way fare for trips starting or ending in Get About's western extended service area (See map on back). Get About's regular service area consists of the four cities of Claremont, La Verne, Pomona and San Dimas. Get About allows riders to travel to destinations beyond Get About's regular service area to the west of these cities as far west as Grand Avenue, in an area north of the I-10 freeway and south of Foothill Blvd. The rider's initial trip must originate in Get About's regular service area. The current fare for travel to and from locations in the western extended service area is \$1.00 per one way trip. The proposed fare change would increase the fare for these trips to \$2.00 a one way trip. The fare increase is proposed to take effect on October 1, 2015.

The public hearing will be held on June 10, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. in the conference room of La Verne City Hall, 3660 D Street, La Verne, California at which all persons are invited to appear and be heard.
