



## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

### **PROPOSAL TO RAISE THE GET ABOUT AGE REQUIREMENT TO 65**

The Pomona Valley Transportation Authority (PVRTA) will be holding a public hearing on **September 13, 2017** to consider a proposal to increase the minimum age for Get About eligibility to 65 years of age. Currently, the eligibility requirements for Get About are as follows:

*“Get About is open to individuals 60 years of age or older and individuals of any age that have a qualifying disability.”*

The proposal under consideration would change the Get About eligibility requirements to read as follows:

*“Get About is open to individuals 65 years of age or older and individuals of any age that have a qualifying disability.”*

The proposed change to the age requirements is needed to bring Get About’s standards in compliance with those of the Federal programs providing financial support to Get About. The proposed change in standards is recommended to take effect January 1., 2018. Riders already registered with Get About, but under the under the age of 65, will remain eligible for the program.

The public hearing will be held on September 13, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. in the conference room of La Verne City Hall, 3660 D Street, La Verne, California at which all persons are invited to appear and be heard.
